Edwards Award for Lifetime Achievement, a winner of the Coretta Scott King, Newbery Honor and Caldecott Honor awards and other awards and honors too numerous to list.

Susan Campbell Bartoletti: Author of 13 picture books, novels and non-fiction works, Ms. Bartoletti is the winner of the Robert F. Sibert Award for Distinguished Information Book, Newbery Honor award, Orbis Pictus Award for distinguished nonfiction from the National Council of Teachers of English and numerous other honors and awards.

Eric Rohmann: Children's author and illustrator of such picture books as *My Friend Rabbit*, Caldecott Medal winner, *Time Flies*, Caldecott Honor Book, *Clara and Ashe*, ALA Notable Children's Book, and his new *The Kitten's Tale*, among others. Mr. Rohmann is noted for the beauty of his illustrations and an eclectic variety of artistic styles.
